

MARCO ANGELONE is Full Professor of Private Law at the Department of Legal and Social Sciences, University “G. d’Annunzio” of Chieti-Pescara.

Associate Professor (since 2017), he previously served as Tenured Researcher of Private Law at the aforementioned University (2014-2017) and at the Polytechnic University of Marche (2007-2014).

Graduated *Magna cum Laude* in Law from LUISS “Guido Carli” (2003), he was a Research Fellow (2006) and obtained a PhD in Civil Law (2009) at the University of Sannio. He completed postgraduate legal training at the Specialisation School for Legal Professions (University of Teramo, 2005). He is also a qualified lawyer registered in the list of full-time University Professors of the Teramo Bar Association and is admitted to practise before the Higher Courts.

He teaches Private Law (since 2012-13); Civil liability (since 2018-19); European and international contract law (since 2019-20) at the University of Chieti-Pescara; Civil Law (since 2023-24) at the “Leonardo da Vinci” University (where he previously taught Institutions of Private Law, from 2016-17 to 2022-23). During 2019-20, he taught Elements of Sport Law and legislation within the Bachelor’s Degree Course in Sports and Physical Education of the University of Chieti-Pescara. He also teaches at the Specialisation School in Civil Law - University of Camerino. He held the position of Professor of Private and cybersecurity law at the University of Chieti-Pescara (2017-18); and of Family and Juvenile Law (2008-09; 2011-12), Private Law with notions of Family Law (2008-09), and Business Law (from 2008-09 to 2013-14) at the Polytechnic University of Marche.

University Delegate for the monitoring of the Strategic Plan (2024–2026) and of the Three-Year Planning Programme (PRO3 2024–2026) at the University of Chieti-Pescara, where he has also been Coordinator of the PhD Programme in Business, Institutions, Markets (BIM) since 2024.

Dean of the Master’s Degree Course in Law of the Telematic University “Leonardo da Vinci” (UniDav), where he also coordinates the Advanced Training Course in “Law and Economics for Business”. He is a member of the Academic Senate, of the Research Quality Assurance Committee (GAQR) of the Department of Human, Legal and Economic Sciences and of the Third Mission Committee at the same Telematic University.

He is member of the Scientific Board of PhD Programme in “*Scienze giuridiche per la sostenibilità, la transizione ecologica e l’innovazione*” (University of Chieti-Pescara) and of PhD Programme in “*Sustainable blue economy and one health*” of the Telematic University “Leonardo da Vinci” (UniDav); previously he served on the Scientific Board of PhD Programme in “*Business, Institutions, Markets*” (University of Chieti-Pescara), in “*Legal and Social Sciences*” (University of Camerino) and in “*Management and Law*” (Polytechnic University of Marche).
